 - A minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) from the university in which the MSW was obtained.
 - Post-MSW Application
 - Resume
 - Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts (if you have never been a graduate student at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign)
 - Proof of one of the following
 - o Successful completion of the TAP
 - o An ACT plus writing score of 22 or higher in the past 10 years with a writing score of 19 if taken prior to 9.2015 or writing score of 16 if taken after 9/2015.
 - o An SAT combined score (critical reading and math) of 1030 or higher and a writing score of 450 or higher in the past 10 years
 - o Successful completion of the Basic Skills Testing.
