# Community Learning Lab (CLL) at the SSW

The CLL is a community engagement program where community partners submit project requests which are then matched to applicable classes, student groups, or individual students whose skills and interests align with the needs of the project. The goal is to be mutually beneficial; community partners have meaningful projects completed on their behalf while students gain hands-on experience that improves their marketability and increases their professional skills. Over 1400 projects have been completed on behalf of community partners since fall of 2013.

## **IL BHWELL HRSA Scholars Program at the SSW**

Illinois BHWELL is a clinical certificate and scholarship program for MSW students who want to learn team-based models for integrating health and mental health services in rural and underserved areas. Student receive a \$10,000 stipend during their field placement
