<b>MAP Therapist Credentialing &amp; Coaching</b>					
Pursuit of MAP Credential is required for all IHB clinical staff and leads. Credentialing must be attained within 12 months of completion of the 5-day MAP course, or staff will be required (by Practicewise) to take the course again and restart the process. The MAP coaching process is a minimum of 6 months, with twice a month consultation, until the trainee is ready to submit a portfolio for credentialing approval. After credentialing is achieved, coaching/boosters continue quarterly, provided by MAP Training Professionals/MAP Instructors. Resubmission of a portfolio occurs every 3 years in order to maintain credential.
